



# Redeemer United Church of Christ

## Sussex, Wisconsin



In 2006 Conservation Land Stewardship, Inc. (CLS) was contracted by CG Schmidt, Inc. to install a landscape that integrated native prairie systems with alternative storm water management techniques for Redeemer United Church of Christ. The design was a joint effort between Conservation Design Forum and Kubala Washatko Architects. CLS was once again retained by Redeemer United Church of Christ in 2009 to design and install a sanctuary garden that fit seamlessly into the native landscape previously installed by CLS

CLS completed installation of the landscape in August of 2006 and the Sanctuary Garden in August 2009. Work at Redeemer United Church of Christ includes:

- Installation of rain gardens and bioswales including aggregate placement, amended soils placement, seed / plant installation, and erosion control fabric installation
- Prairie, meadow, low maintenance turf, and turf seed installation
- Native tree installation
- Hardscape installation including limestone and segmental retaining walls.
- Creation of an integrated trail system
- Stewardship and maintenance
- Sanctuary garden design and installation
